Chaplain's Corner Thoughts From Fr. Kill

Update on my condition:

Email dated 9 Jun 2009

I nearly died last Thursday, May 28; I had a terrible case of cellulites. I spent two days in the hospital in Ozamiz with a doctor who did not know what he was doing at all. It did not make much difference because I could not get out of Ozamiz due to heavy vacation travel. All boats and planes were full until the third day (Wednesday). By the time I arrived in Cebu on Thursday morning, my BP was 80/50; heart rate 157, my kidneys were failing and sepsis had begun to set in. I was totally dehydrated and my temperature was 38.7 Centigrade. Even one more hour and it might have been too late for them to bring me back from the brink.

I spent three days in the ICU as they continued stabilization. I am now in a regular room with lots of antibiotics flowing in all day and all night. I am much better now. It is almost two weeks now.

I am slowly recovering. It will be at least another week they say before I get out of the hospital. After that, I will still stay in Cebu for a week or two and check in with the different doctors. It looks like it will be July before I am free to go home to Ozamiz. The doctors took off a lot of skin. The good news is that the areas where the skin has been removed are healing very fast. Another good sign is that my white blood count dropped considerably in the past 24 hours. It started at 27,000 then held at 20,000 for three days. After that it dropped to 17,000 and stayed there until this morning. This morning it was down to 9,000, which is near normal.

Generally I am doing much better. The swelling is way down and the infection is mostly gone. Most of the skin on my lower

leg has been removed and that did a lot to help the healing. It would have come off anyway; the surgical intervention just hastened the process.

On Thursday I will go off of the IV Antibiotics and onto oral doses. They will still be high doses but not be on the IV all the time allows me a lot more freedom of movement.

Some of the docs are talking about releasing me from the hospital by the end of the week or early next week. However, they all want me to stay here in Cebu for at least one week, if not two weeks yet so they can continue to monitor my progress.

One troubling issue is my heart. I have had an irregular heartbeat for years. It skips a beat or two now and again. Since this incident started two weeks ago, the irregularity has been somewhat constant. That was one of the reasons they threw me into the ICU upon arrival at the hospital. My heart rate was 157 bpm as opposed to a regular heartbeat of 72 bpm. Now, it is intermittently regular and irregular. Once this "crisis" is over the doc want to do more tests on the heart. They have put me on drugs to regulate the heartbeat.

That is one of the reasons that I will have to stay here in Cebu for so long.

Email dated 10 June 2009

I will be released on Friday but will have to stay in Cebu for a couple of weeks yet for further test on my heart and monitoring of the progress of the leg. Thanks be to God I have reached this milestone.

Please keep the prayers coming as we tend to all of the side "issues" that have arisen as a result of this crisis.

Email dated 14 June 2009

June 24 is the 37th Anniversary of my ordination.

Latest news is that I am actually out of the hospital and staying in a Pension House, which is actually a hotel. The same would cost \$60 to \$70 a night in the USA here it is less than \$30 a night and includes full breakfast for two people.

Another bit of great news is that of the ten doctors who worked to save me and move the healing process along, not one of them charged us a penny for their services. May God bless them.
