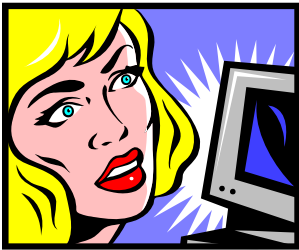

Chaplain's Corner

Thoughts From Fr. Kill

As September 11 draws near I think it is good to look back and once again ponder what happened on that day and the days following this great tragedy.

One might ask, "Why were we Americans so united? We would not resemble one another even if you painted us all one color! We speak all the languages of the world and form an astonishing mixture of civilizations and religious beliefs.

And yet, on 9/11, the American tragedy turned three hundred million people into a nation of people who held hand over heart. Nobody rushed to accuse the White House, the Army, or the Secret Service of being only a bunch of losers.

Nobody rushed to empty their bank accounts and thus start runs on the banks that would mean financial disaster as well. Few rushed out onto the streets nearby to gape about.

Instead we Americans volunteered to donate blood and to give a helping hand.

After the first moments of panic, our flags were raised even over the smoking ruins, and soon people were putting on T-shirts, caps and ties in the colors of our national flag. We placed flags on buildings and cars as if in every place and on every car a government official or the president was passing. On every public occasion, we started singing 'God Bless America!' In the Philippines I prominently hung our flag that day to join in the mourning and to join in the prayers for strength and compassion and unity in our nation.

From the Philippines, I watched the live broadcast and rerun after rerun for hours listening to the story of the guys who went down one hundred floors with a woman in a wheelchair without knowing who she was, and of the California hockey player, who gave his life fighting with the terrorists and prevented one plane from hitting a target that could have killed other hundreds or thousands of people. I heard of the hundreds of fire fighters who gave their lives trying to save the thousands still trapped on the upper floors of the building of the World

Trade Center.

Imperceptibly, with every word and musical note, the memory of some turned into a modern myth of tragic heroes. And with every phone call, millions and millions of dollars were put into collection aimed at rewarding not a man or a family, but a spirit, which no money can buy.

How on earth were we able to respond united as one being so different in our politics, religion and cultural heritage? What on earth could unite the American people in such way? Was it our bountiful land? Was it our history of waging war against aggressors? Was it the knowledge of our economic power? I pondered these questions for hours and days as the tragedy unfolded and the heroism of the many became more and more real to those of us living abroad. I came to only one conclusion ... Only the desire for freedom can work such miracles.

It was the same urge for freedom which has three times drawn the Filipino people together to throw off the burdens of dictators and unbearably corrupt government. First it was the Spanish, and then it was the Marcos dictatorship, and finally the ouster of the Estrada Administration. These last two were accomplished without a shot being fired. It was accomplished solely through force of will, of good standing together against evil regardless of cultural background or language spoken. The Philippines is a nation not only of varied culture and language, it is also divided by 7,000 islands and diverse religious beliefs. They, like we Americans cry out for freedom and that yearning can bring all people together if we will but stand together as good against evil. It will give us freedom from war and terror and freedom to all of God's children
